# IMPORTANT INFORMATION IN RELATION TO ONLINE MARKING, EXAMINATION PAPER DESIGN AND STATIONERY DESIGN 2025

# To the Management Authorities of Post-primary Schools and other Entities recognised by the SEC to hold examinations

## The purpose of this circular is to provide information on:

School authorities should instruct all Leaving Certificate and Junior Cycle candidates about what to expect in the examinations on foot of the information in this circular including the appendices.

#### 1. Online Marking in Leaving Certificate and Junior Cycle subjects 2025

The majority of subjects in the **Leaving Certificate and Junior Cycle examinations** are now marked online. In addition for 2025, the following Non-Curricular Leaving Certificate Languages will also be marked online: Bulgarian, Croatian, Czech, Danish, Dutch, Estonian, Finnish, Hungarian, Latvian, Maltese, Modern Greek, Romanian, Slovakian, Slovenian, Swedish and Ukrainian. Please see the full list of online marked subjects in **Appendix 1**.

#### 2. Information for Candidates

Candidates sitting any of the examinations in subjects which will be marked online should be made aware of the following:

• Candidates are required to write their **Examination number** and their **Date of Birth** in the spaces provided on the front cover of all answerbooks and all stationery returned at the end of an examination session.

As part of the SEC resulting process we check each candidate's examination number against their date of birth, as they have entered it. This is a critical part of the process and **it is imperative that candidates complete their details correctly on each script** so that we can reconcile their information in the online marking system.

- Candidates must complete their responses in blue or black pen. Coloured pens, gel pens, highlighters or erasable pens must not be used. The scanning process may not capture what the candidate has written on the page if anything other than blue or black pen is used. Text not captured in the scanning process will not be visible to the examiner for marking. Pencils and coloured pencils may be used for completing diagrams and graphs.
- On the Leaving Certificate answerbook candidates must indicate the subject, level and language version (Gaeilge or English) for which the answerbook is being used. To do this they must fully shade in the relevant circles on the cover. Accuracy when completing this is vital to ensure that the script is routed to the correct examiner for marking see **Appendix 2** for example.
- On the Leaving Certificate answerbook, candidates are required to begin each question on a new page and to clearly write each question number in the space provided.
- Candidates should not use correction fluid (such as *Tippex*) on examination material. Where a candidate makes an error, they should just cross out the error, and continue with their work. This is the case for all subjects, whether they are marked manually or online, as there is a possibility that the cancelled work may merit the award of marks. It should therefore be crossed out but left visible to the examiner.
- Candidates should complete their responses using the spaces provided on the examination paper or in the answerbook as appropriate to the subject to ensure that all of their responses are captured in the scanning process. Anything outside of these areas or in the margins may not be seen by the examiner.

## 3. Examination Paper Design

There is no material change to the content of examination papers as a result of them being marked online.

Broadly speaking, there are three different formats of Leaving Certificate examination papers:

- 1. Examinations consisting of a returnable question-and-answerbook that incorporates all the questions and the spaces for answering them. Where relevant, graph pages and other specialised stationery will be incorporated into the returnable question-and-answerbook.
- 2. Examinations consisting of a returnable question-and-answerbook that incorporates the short answer questions and the spaces for answering them, as well as the lined pages for answering the longer response questions. The longer response questions themselves are presented in a separate question paper. Where relevant, graph pages and other specialised stationery will be incorporated into the returnable question-and-answerbook
- 3. Examinations in which the question paper is separate from the answerbook or other stationery used. In these examinations, candidates answer all questions in the Leaving Certificate answerbook.

See **Appendix 3** for a full list of the subjects being marked online that will use a returnable question-andanswerbook, as well as those being marked online that will use the Leaving Certificate answerbook.

At Junior Cycle, all subjects have a returnable question-and-answerbook format. Where graph paper and other specialised stationery is required, this is included in each of the relevant Junior Cycle question-and-answerbooks.

#### 4. Examination Stationery Design

SEC-appointed superintendents will be provided with the following stationery products which will be used for all subjects, whether marked online or on paper.

i. A 36-page Leaving Certificate answerbook for use in all Leaving Certificate subjects where a separate answerbook is required.

In addition to the front cover and some instructions on page 2, the answerbook has 34 lined pages.

Candidates must indicate the subject, level and language version on the front cover of the answerbook. Accuracy when completing this is vital to ensure that the script is routed to the correct examiner. Please see **Appendix 2** for a completed sample of the front cover.

# ii. Supplementary stationery. There are three Leaving Certificate and two Junior Cycle supplementary stationery products. Leaving Certificate

- 1. A 4-page supplementary answerbook consisting of a **White coloured** cover page and three lined pages for Leaving Certificate.
- 2. A 4-page supplementary Graph Paper answerbook consisting of a **White coloured** cover page and three pages of graph paper for Leaving Certificate.

3. A 4-page Accounting stationery answerbook consisting of a **White coloured** cover page and three pages of accounting paper for Leaving Certificate.

## Junior Cycle

- 1. A 4-page supplementary answerbook consisting of a **Green coloured** cover page and three lined pages for Junior Cycle.
- 2. A 4-page supplementary Graph Paper answerbook consisting of a **Green coloured** cover page and three pages of graph paper for Junior Cycle.

Please see **Appendix 4** for the cover of each of the five supplementary paper products.

**Teachers should not instruct students to request supplementary answerbooks at the start of an examination**. In line with the SEC's longstanding instructions in all examinations, Superintendents will not hand out supplementary answerbooks at the start of the examination and are instructed to provide supplementary answerbooks to candidates only when they have used the space in their main answerbook.

In certain subjects which require the use of the Leaving Certificate answerbook, such as Leaving Certificate Chemistry, Physics, and Engineering, candidates often require the use of graph paper. As the Leaving Certificate answerbook does not contain graph paper, the supplementary graph paper stationery will be made available upon request by the candidate. Similarly, the supplementary Accounting stationery will be made available upon request.

## (1) Completed front cover of a Leaving Certificate Answerbook

The example below shows the completed front cover of a Leaving Certificate Answerbook where candidate 269999 whose date of birth is 24<sup>th</sup> November 2006, is taking History at Higher level through the medium of English. Candidates should write their examination number and date of birth in a clear and legible manner using blue or black pen as demonstrated below:


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Note: Candidates often make a mistake when completing the "Date of Birth" on the front cover of examination stationery. Instead of inserting their own Date of Birth, they commonly insert either the example date provided (03/02/05) or the date on which the examination is being sat. In order to ensure the accurate and speedy processing of results, great care should be taken by candidates when completing **all** sections on the cover of the examination stationery.




