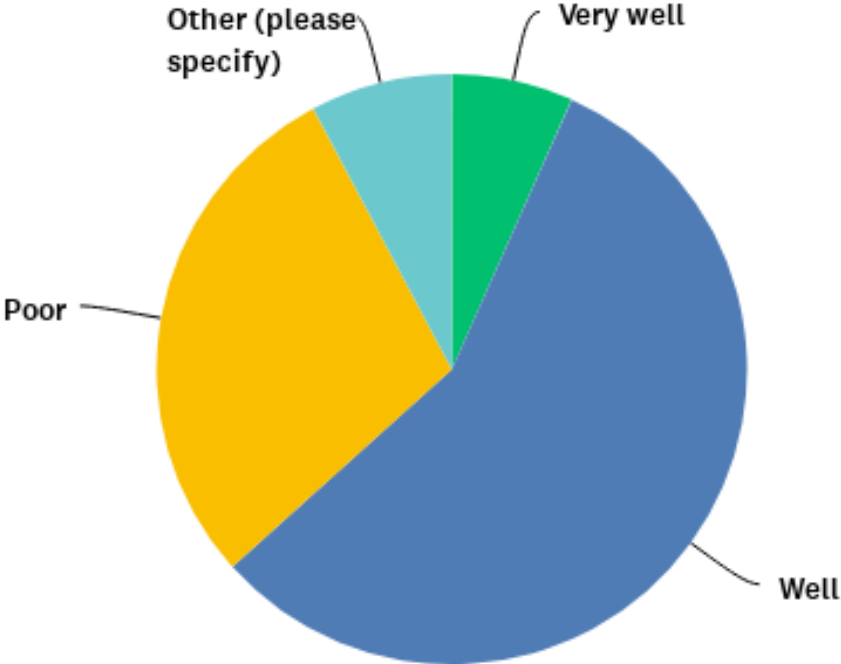

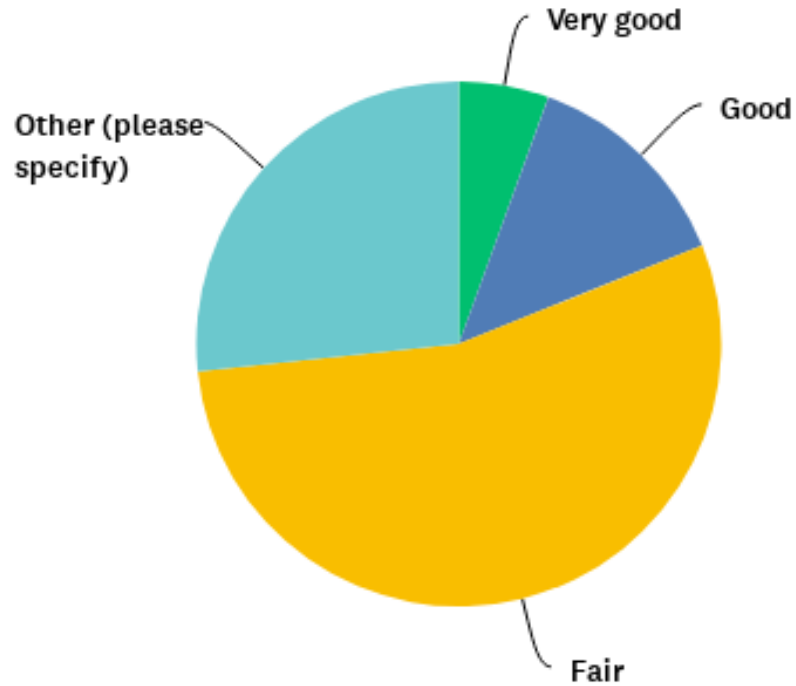
Q1: Overall, how do you feel you are managing the workload at present?

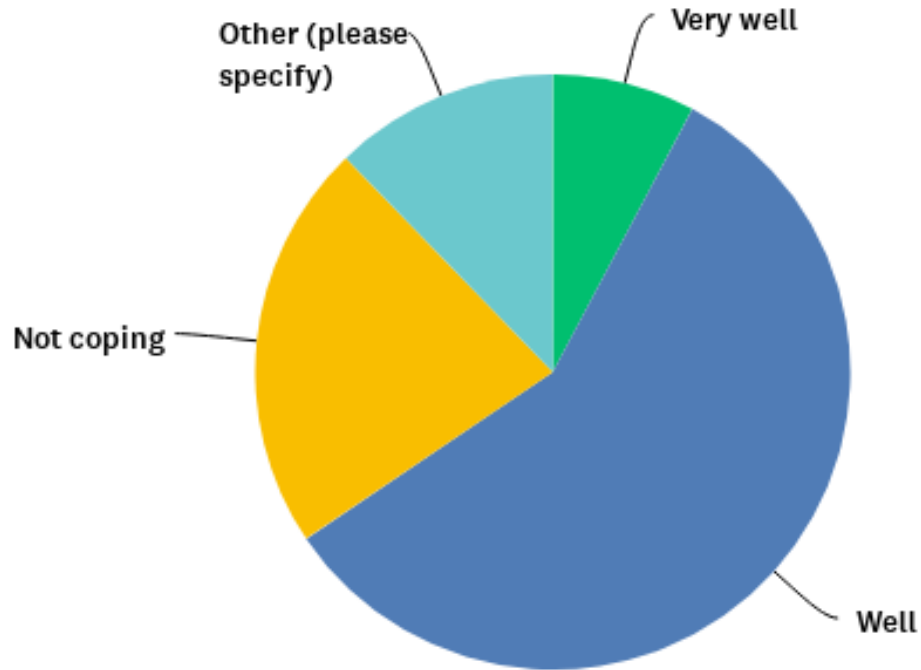

‘Hard to stay motivated because of the unknown with the Leaving Certificate’
