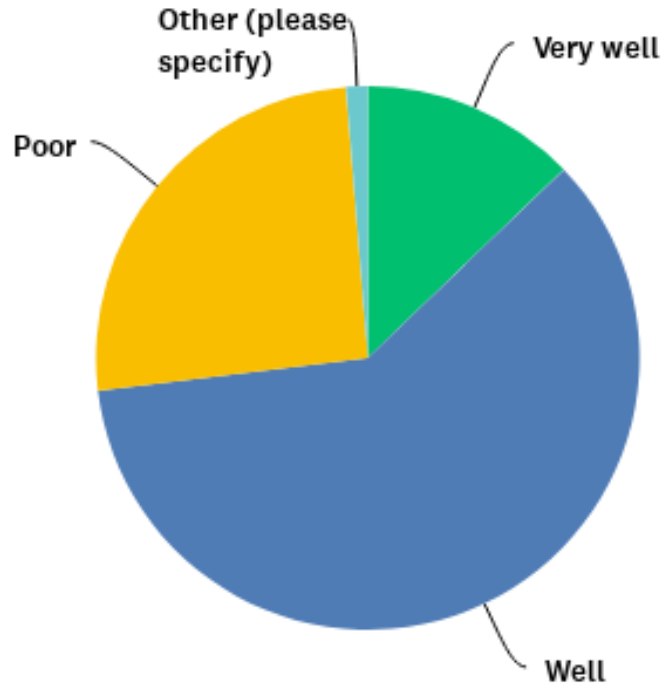

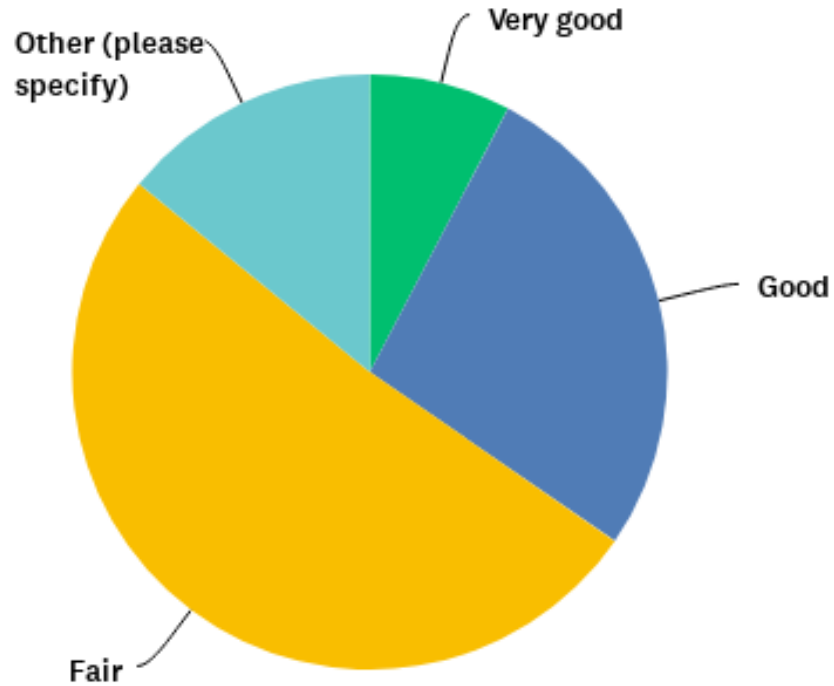

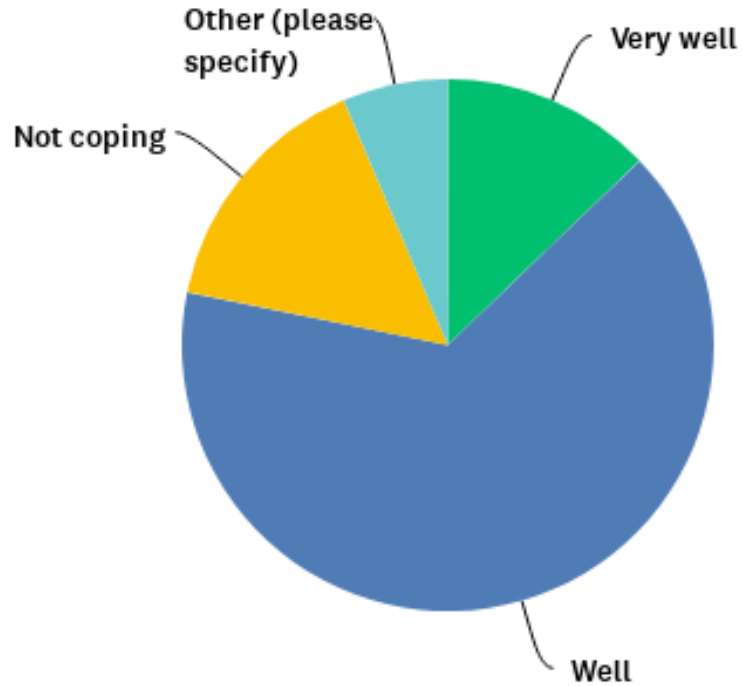

Please see below a summary of the responses we received and actions the school will take to address these:

‘Too much homework’

Response: It can be difficult to balance the workload from each subject and teacher. All you can do is your best with the resources you have at home. Please inform your teachers if you feel the workload is too much. It is important to manage your time effectively. Please use your Religion, P.E & Wellbeing classes to take a screen-break, get some fresh air, exercise. This will help replenish your work throughout the day.

Of the surveys completed 65% of 5th Year students have acknowledged that their motivation for school work is low and that they are missing the social interaction with peers

Response: We understand how challenging it is to work remotely and at this age to not spend time with friends. Our Year Heads are keeping in touch with form classes and the Management Team enjoyed meeting the 5th Years recently. The half day before midterm was welcomed and we will continue to monitor this going forward. We also hope to encourage students (where possible) to keep their cameras on so that the live class can feel more interactive and students can see their classmates. Depending on the subject and nature of the class this is not always possible but where the teacher asks for cameras on, please participate.
