### Christmas Portfolio Assessment

- Starts Thursday 16th December
- 15 Minute Interview With 2 teachers
- Timetable available here: Christmas Portfolio Timetable 2021
- Students must arrive 30 minutes before their timetabled spot to go through a pre-interview assessment with year head (Grades & Projects, School record, attendances etc.)
- Students must have all work completed or they will not be sent for interview
- Once they go for interview they will sign in to their google account on the classroom computer and display their digital portfolio.
- Teachers will interview them based on portfolio content AND how TY is going in general.
- They must have 6 pieces of graded project work displayed for assessment
- A google form has been distributed All students must complete before interview This
  will ask for a published link to portfolio, projects and grades as well as goals and
  achievements for the year so far

## Student Digital Portfolios - Christmas Checklist

For your Christmas portfolio assessment you must have:

- Introduction to your portfolio and yourself Hobbies, interests etc.
- At a minimum you should have 12 subjects included Each on their own page!
  - Each subject should (preferably) have samples of work or a description of what you have been doing in class (This can be in the form of pictures, videos, text...however you choose)
- Work Experience included as its own page
  - Work Experience project also included here
- Community Week included as its own page (If you have done it)
- Gaisce information Personal, Physical & Community
- Trips & Activities section Carlingford, Mountain Biking etc.
- Careers workshops content
  - CV (Updated), cover letter, interview questions etc.
- Anything else you would like to showcase....show us what you spend your time doing!
- Create talking points Mini Company, Sports, Workshops etc.
- 6 GRADED pieces of work displayed on your portfolio in a variety of subject areas
- You should also have a variety of other work showcased for different subjects



## Important Points

#### Make sure you have:

- Your portfolio organised each subject should have its own page
- Changed the sharing settings on any google document you have displayed on your portfolio



- Click 'Publish' after you make any changes
- Send your published link to someone to check your portfolio functions correctly





#### Compulsory and stand alone elements:

1. You must have a Digital Portfolio that is ready for presenting with 6 GRADED PROJECTS minimum along with all other content outlined in your computer classes

2. Work Experience - All files submitted & passed

3. Gaisce - Minimum 15 Diary Entries in online account

4. ALL projects assigned by teachers completed



## Portfolio Assessment Continued

#### What you can do now!

- Get your absences explained Check with form teacher or myself
  - a. All unexplained absences are marked negatively
- School Journal This will be spot checked in pre-interview Show you are using it.
- 3. You must have all reflections complete in Tutorials Classroom
- 4. Minimum 15 diary entries in your online Gaisce Account
- 5. Work experience documents finished, submitted and passed!

Be on time - Strict timing in place for interviews

Full uniform for interviews

No Jackets or jumpers - School Jumper, Shirt & Tie

No shaking hands

Be talkative - positive - relax and enjoy

Be prepared!

Talk us through your " " project....

Is there any project you are particularly proud of?

What subjects have you found the most interesting?

How have you challenged yourself?

How are you spending your time outside school?

Are there any highlights from the year?

How did the year benefit you?

How has the year impacted on your career preferences/subject choices so far?

Is there anything else you would like to say/show etc...?
