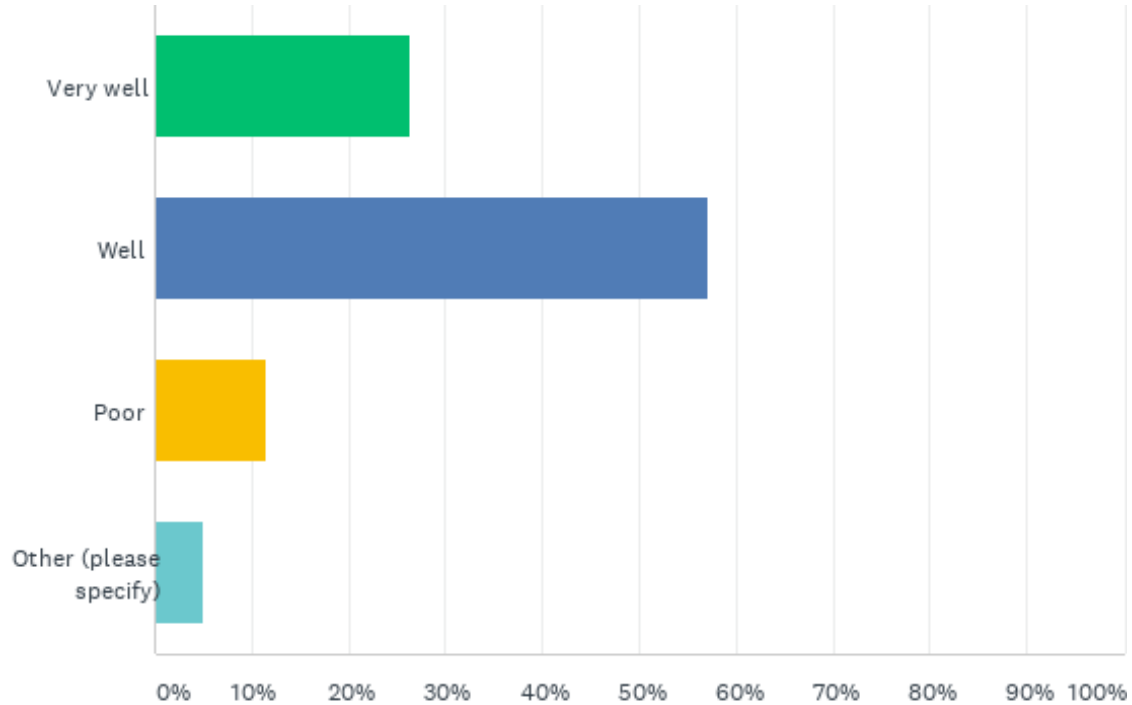

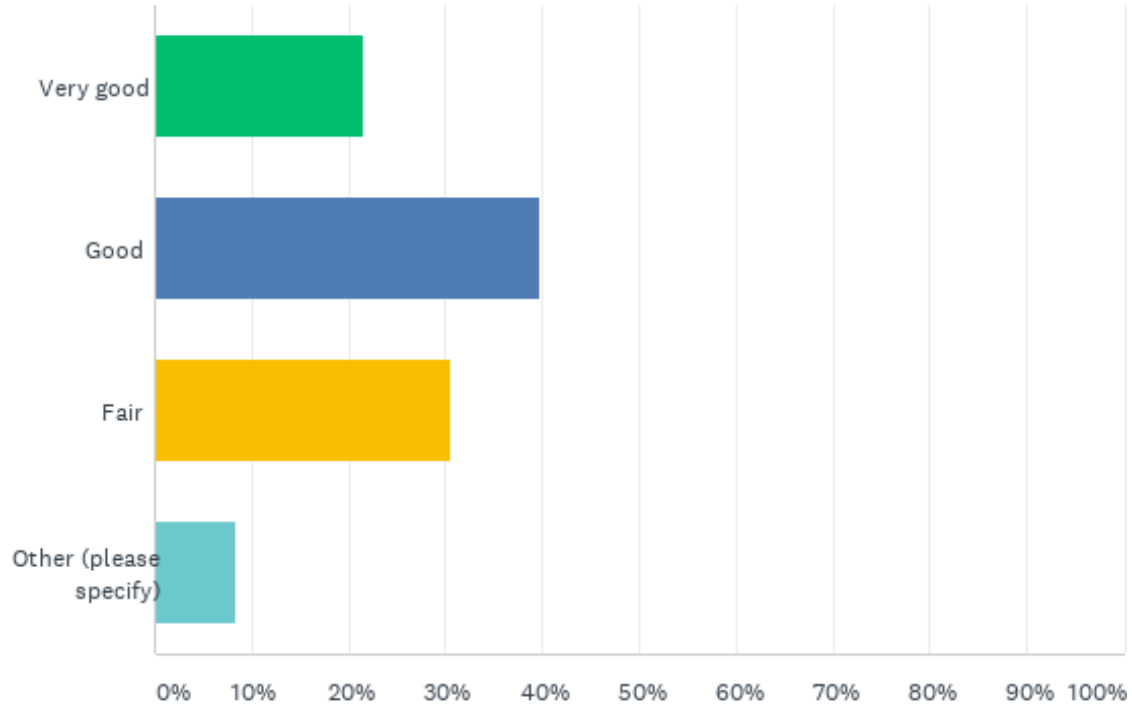

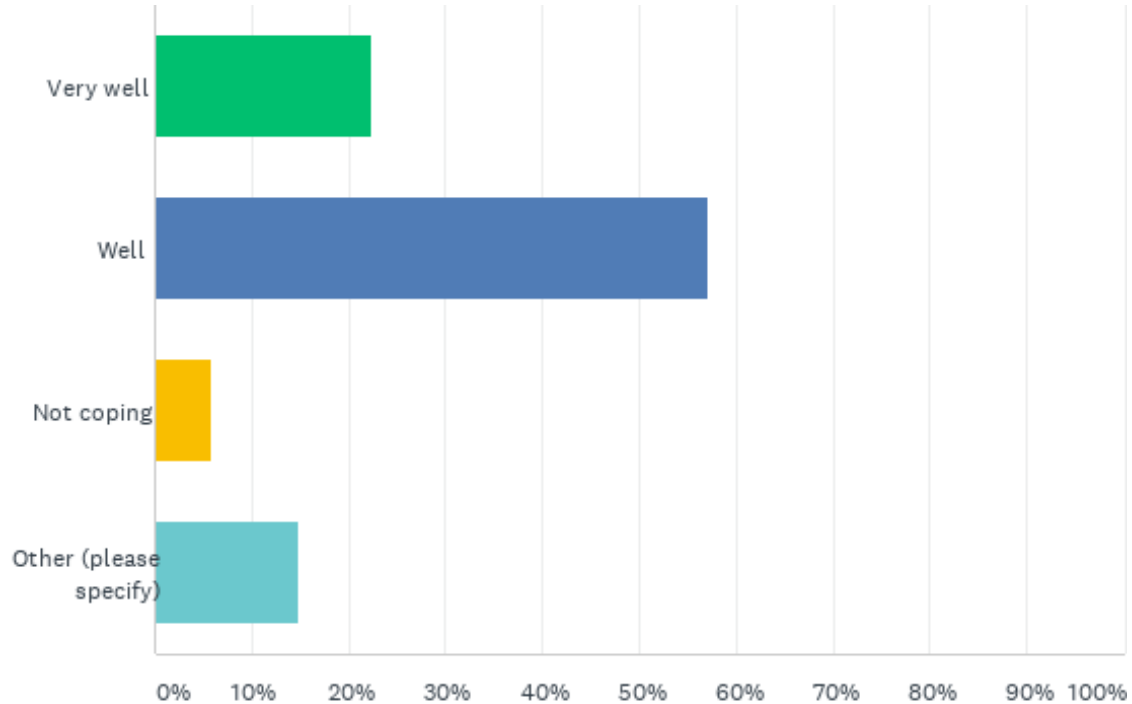

Q.4 Do you have any feedback that you would like to share with us?

Please see below a summary of the responses we received and actions the school will take to address these:

- **2nd Year students seem to be doing well with remote learning but parents are worried about the quality of work their son is actually doing.**

Action: Parent Teacher Meeting Reports will be completed for 2nd Year students and available to parents and guardians on VSWare before Easter. An app notification will be sent when these are available. This will give parents and guardians feedback as to how their son is getting on and what he needs to focus on going forward.

- **Almost 40% of parents and guardians identified that their son's motivation was low at present and that he is getting tired sitting at the laptop all day and missing the social interaction with their peers.**

Action: We are very conscious of how difficult it can be for both staff and students conducting themselves online all day. We have asked teachers of 1st & 2nd Year students to try complete work during class time to help reduce screen time in the evening. The half day before midterm was also welcomed. We will continue to monitor this going forward. We also hope to encourage students (where possible) to keep their cameras on so that the live class can feel more interactive and students can see their classmates. Depending on the subject and nature of the class this is not always possible but where the teacher asks for cameras on please encourage your son from home to participate.

- **'CBS teachers are doing very well given the extreme circumstances – thank you'.**

Many thanks for your positive feedback, we will pass this onto our staff. Everyone is doing their best at the moment and we hope to have the 2nd Years back in the school very soon.
