In 2015 Transport accounted for 19.8% of Ireland's greenhouse gas emissions.

## BE & STAR, AND DITCH YOUR CAR!

Just over 4 in 10 secondary students travelled to school as a passenger in a car, up 16 per cent on 2011.

Only 12% of Irish teens reach the recommended levels of physical activity in a week.



- Almost 3 in 10 secondary students used the bus.
- Just over a fifth of secondary students walked to school (74,111) up slightly from 73,946 (0.2%) in 2011
- Over 200 in Co. Kildare drove themselves, ranked 6th in the country



- The 25 years, from 1986 to 2011, saw an 87 per cent decrease in the numbers cycling to secondary school.
  - A total of just over 7000 students cycle to school.
