- ✓ We stay at a top hotel at Marne La Valee only minutes from Disneyland which has a swimming pool.
- ✓ The hotel is called STAYCITY Marne La Valee.
- ✓ All breakfasts and dinners are included and are top quality.
- ✓ Dinner on the last day, Monday 11th is not included.
- ✓ All entry to both Disneyland and Parc Asterix is included, access to all rides is included.
- ✓ The total price which includes everything will be approx. €725
- ✓ The total cost can be paid on-line in instalments of as much or as little as often as you wish.
- ✓ Deposits must be paid before October 30th the final instalment must be paid before February 2022.
- ✓ There are no additional costs or expenses.
- ✓ Accommodation and meals are of the highest quality.

- ✓ This will be the 10th FIRST year school tour and they have all always been hugely successful and a great experience for the boys.
- ✓ It would be limited to the first 65 students.
- ✓ Currently, French government guidelines require all children and leaders on school tours to be vaccinated and be able to produce a Covid vaccination cert. This may well be the case in April also.
