Summer Portfolio Assessment

- Starts **Monday 27th May**
- 15 - 20 Minute Interview - With 2 teachers
- Timetable available soon
- You must arrive 20 minutes before your timetabled spot to go through a pre-interview assessment with year head (School record, attendances etc.)
- Teachers will interview you based on portfolio content AND how TY has been in general for you
- You must have **12 pieces of graded project work** displayed for assessment
- **4 pieces ONLY can be used from Christmas**
- A google form will be distributed the week before to upload published link to portfolio - All students must complete before interview -

For your Summer portfolio assessment you should upgrade your digital portfolios to have:

- **Introduction to your Portfolio and yourself** - Hobbies , interests etc.
- **12 GRADED pieces of work** (4 from Christmas only) shown on your portfolio in a variety of subject areas
- You should also have a **variety of other work showcased for different subjects**
 - This can be in the form of pictures, videos, text...however you choose
- **At a minimum you should have 12 subjects** included
 - Each subject should (preferably) have samples of work or a description of what you have been doing in class
- **Work Experience Files** that are created over the next few weeks
 - Career Investigations, placement projects etc.
- **Gaisce information** - Personal, Physical & Community
- **Careers workshops content**
 - CV (Updated), cover letter, interview questions, project
- Anything else you would like to showcase....show us what you spend your time doing!
- Create talking points - Mini Company, Sports, Workshops etc.



Grading & Awards

1. All teachers submit grades and comments through VSware, which are then sent to parents through the app
2. Students will also receive a year head report through VSware on the app

Quality of Project Work & Assessment (30%)

Familiarity with Project Work (20%)
